The Lokahi Program, a partnership between KHON2 and The Salvation Army, works to brighten the holidays and provide basic needs for more than 18,000 individuals and families each year. There are many different ways to help us get the gifts and food out to the many island families that need them throughout the season. The following are suggested items:

### **Baby Items:**

Diapers of all sizes, even the large and extra large (good night) diapers for the older children. Baby toiletries such as “no more tears” shampoo, conditioner, baby lotion, oil and baby wipes. Formula and baby foods.

### **Teen Gifts:**

CD's of all types, sports equipment, gift certificates for stores where teens like to shop, such as music stores, surf shops, etc. Make-up, toiletries, and hair accessories are what they like.

### **Teens & Family:**

Activity passes or gift certificates to places such as Sea Life Park, Water Park, Zoo, Fun Factory, movies and any activities the family can enjoy together. Gift certificates/cards to any stores like K-Mart or Wal-Mart for food and clothes and all family necessities.

### **Household:**

Kitchenware, linens, towels, toiletries, shampoo, bath soap, laundry detergent, toilet paper, Kleenex, paper towels, dish soap and kid's toiletries like bubble bath, and bath foam.

### **Food:**

Any non-perishable food or food gift certificates. Individual snack and juice boxes for kids to take to school, cereal, etc.

**Gift Cards:** to anywhere

### **Educational Toys:**

For all ages -- newborn through teens. Educational and non-violent toys are preferred such as books, art supplies, creative toys, school supplies, and back packs.
